Based upon the successful analyses of proficiency testing samples, acceptable initial demonstrations of capability, standard operating procedures and the Quality Assurance Plan, Western Environmental Testing (NV00932), located at 3230 Polaris Ave., Las Vegas NV 89102, is granted Interim Certification by the State of Nevada for the analyses of Colilert™, Presence/Absence in drinking water by *Standard Methods* (SM) 9223-B.

Interim Certification is also granted for: Fecal Coliforms by SM9222-D using mFC media; Total Coliform and *Escherichia Coli* by 9223-B, Colilert™ Quantitray; Carbonaceous and Biochemical Oxygen Demand by SM5210-B and Dissolved Oxygen by SM4500-O G in waste water.

Interim Certification is effective December 29th, 2011 and will remain in effect until an on-site assessment can be performed. An acceptable on-site assessment will result in full certification through July 31st, 2012.

This Certification is valid only as long as Western Environmental Testing (NV00932) maintains compliance with the applicable State of Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS 445A) and Administrative Codes (NAC) 445A.0552, NAC445A.542-.5496 and/or NAC459.96902-.9699.

This letter supersedes the interim certification letter dated December 29th, 2011 and shall serve as official notice to you and your clients until you receive the 2011-2012 scope.
